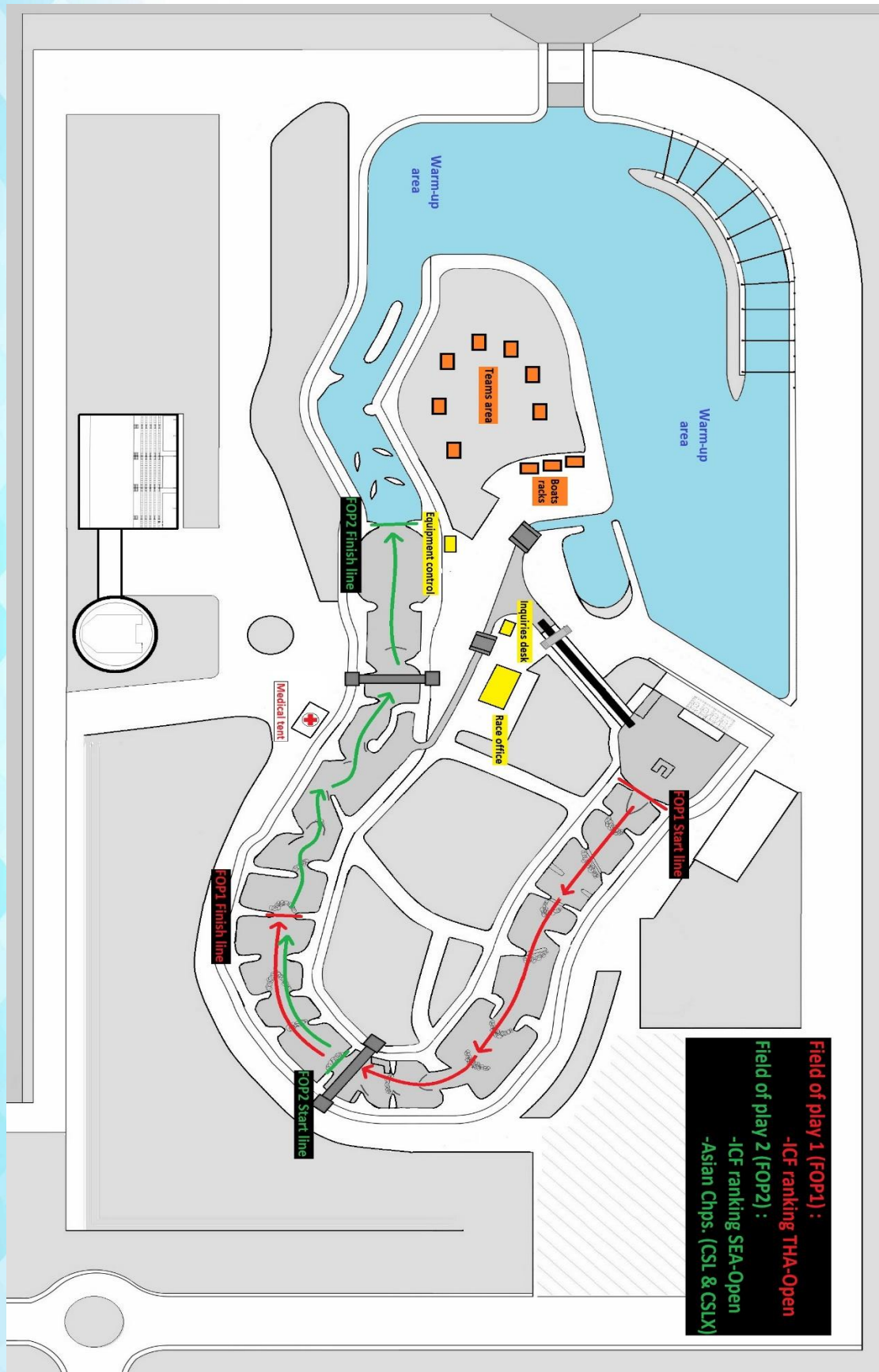

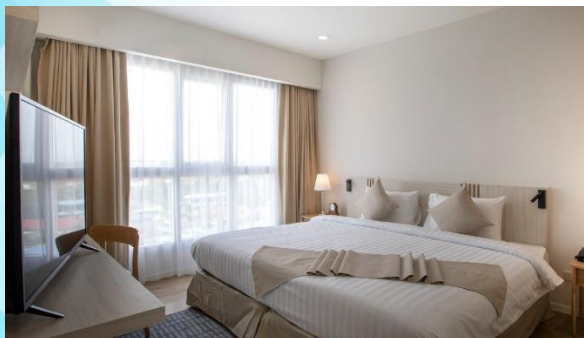

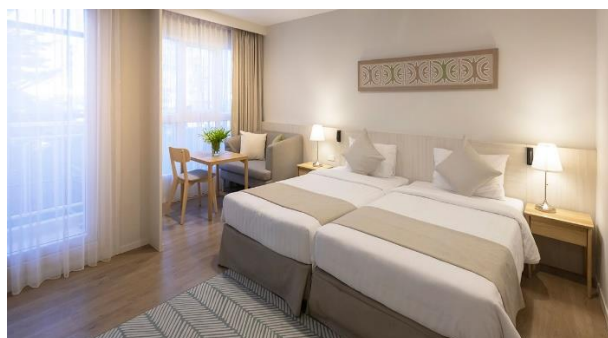

## 8. TRANSPORTATION

### Airport Transfer Upon Arrival and Departure

Airport transfer fares (Airport – Official hotel – Airport) varied due to the distances as follows:
